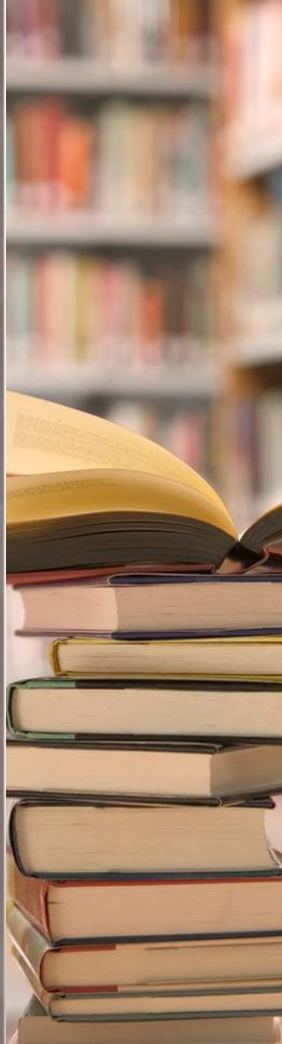

Partnership working



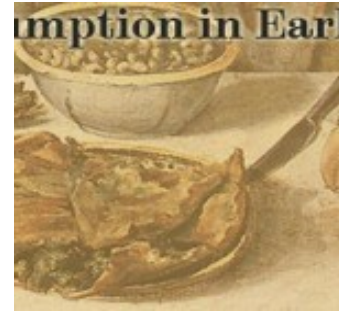
- Valuable for student experience
- Valuable for staff – broadening research collaborations
- Valuable for Impact
- Valuable strategically
 - Phasing out of CDAs
 - By 2017 10% of WROCAH studentships **should** be with external partners
 - AHRC DTP2 10% requirement

White Rose Studentship Networks

- 1 research theme; 3 PhD topics
- 1 or more external partners
- 1 network lead
- 3 students, one registered at each University, fully funded at WRoCAH levels (full training package, but not lab costs etc!)
- 3 supervisors, one at each University
- 3 co-supervisors, each at a different University

- Faith in Food and Food in Faith: Interdisciplinary Perspectives on Dietary Practice

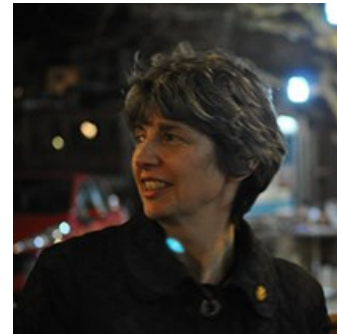


2015 networks

 - Languages (Leeds) / Journalism (Sheffield)
 - History (Sheffield)/ English (York)
 - History (York)/ Fine Art (Leeds)

Selection criteria

- The **added value** of the collaboration (in what way does the network provide an opportunity for collaboration which would not otherwise exist).
- The **strategic relevance** of the network to White Rose universities/WRoCAH, and the extent and nature of interaction with appropriate external non-HEI organisations.
- The **sustainability** of the network and its potential for long term collaboration.
- The **novelty, timeliness and clarity** of the studentships overall.
- Do the proposed supervisory teams have **satisfactory track records**?
- Are **resources and facilities** adequate?

Application procedure

- Call launch – Tuesday 24 November
- Closing deadline for applications **5pm on Friday 4 March 2016**

NB: *Physical signatures required from HODs and Partner Organisations, so leave yourselves plenty of time!*

- Applications will be reviewed by Deans of A&H at Leeds, Sheffield and York
- Networks will be confirmed by **18 March 2015**
- Recruitment of students to Networks should be against similar criteria to AHRC Competition
 - Quality of student, quality of project, fit with WRoCAH + **fit with Network**
